THE ANGEL OF THE NORTH CHALLENGE 5pts

The sculpture was built to remember the past, look forward to the future and as a focus for human hopes and fears.

Create a journal or picture book of your life, showing the highlights so far, what you are hoping for in the future, and how you think God will help you overcome your fears for the future. Include lots of photos or drawings you have done. Share it with your family or club leader and ask them to pray for you and the rest of the Adventurers taking part in this camporee challenge.

Ellen G White said: We have nothing to fear for the future, except as we shall forget the way the Lord has led us, and His teaching in our past history. (CET 204.1) Share your testimony about how the Lord has led you or a friend/family member in the past. You can record a video, write it down or even turn it into a poem. Make sure if it is someone else's story that you have their permission to share.

Ellen G White said: We have nothing to fear for the future, except as we shall forget the way the Lord has led us, and His teaching in our past history. (CET 204.1) Interview an older church member or a senior relative and ask them to share how God has led them in their lives. Record (or write down) their testimony and then using this research, turn their story into a memory book with photos, scripture verses, drawing and quotes alongside their stories. You can present them with the book as a gift at the end of the challenge period. YORK MINSTER CHALLENGE 5pts

This spectacular building was completed in 1472 and is one of the largest of its kind in Northern Europe. Its East Window is the largest medieval stained glass in the world.
